### **Board of Directors**

- New BoD members has been elected

### **Portfolios**

#### **President**

### VP Corporate Relations

- Restructuring of CR team

### VP Competitions

- DMCC
  - Recruitment has been completed for case comps' coaches
  - Upcoming Case Competitions
    - Jeux du Commerce (JDC), Happening Marketing (HM), Financial Open (FO)
  - Discussions with faculty and external parties for international competitions and other opportunities
