2023 First Year Council elections


- 1297 members voted for a total of 15.7% (down from 20.8% last year)
 - Shorter voting period than last year (10 days as compared to 13 days)
- 3 out of 5 positions contested
 - More candidates and contested positions than last year
- Promoted
 - Online, across Instagram, and listservs
 - Through campaign chairs

For the Future - Issues with the number of candidates and voter apathy

- *Relatively* high abstention rates
 - Lowest President (14.7%), highest VP Finance (25.4%)

Fall 2023 Referendum

- 8401 overall votes cast, with a total turnout of 35.1% (12.5 percentage points higher than last year, which was already 6 percentage points than the previous year), highest turnout ever reached
- The trend indicates renewed interest in Fall Referendums
- 9 questions: 7 fee questions and 1 policy question
- Questions passed:
 - Creation of the Student Nutrition Accessibility Club Fee 65.7% yes
 - Safety Services Fee Increase 58.7% yes
 - Creation of the Community Solidarity Fund, Fee, and Solidarity
 Funding Committee 57.8% yes
 - Ratification of the Board of Directors Members 78.9% yes
 - Policy Against Genocide in Palestine Question 78.7% yes


