- Parking Passes to Indigenous students commuting from Kanien'keha:ka territories
 - Last year this was introduced not as an official policy but instead just as a project.
 - The committee wants to make it into a formal policy as it proves to the student body that SSMU recognizes the difficulty which students living in these territories may face in accessing transportation options. Creating an official policy will also provide more stability to the Indigenous student population at McGill.
 - o (Status: Policy still on first draft)
- Indigenous Equity Fund
 - This is another project from last year that wasn't fully formed.
 - The committee is working towards finishing this so that the indigenous students can access an equity fund in a timely manner, even if the IAC position is yet to be filled.
 - More about it: "The Indigenous Equity Fund (IEF) intends to provide financial assistance to Indigenous undergraduate individuals, groups, and Indigenous initiatives in the McGill community and to enable these groups and individuals to choose, based on their personal and community needs, where the financial assistance should be allocated. This includes support for Indigenous communities' defense of their land and individuals who wish to travel to join these defenses to provide aid to communities beyond McGill. This funding empowers and meets the supportive and holistic needs of Indigenous students, such as cost of living expenses, health and wellbeing expenses, and Indigenous community building measures for a thriving and dynamic Indigenous student experience"

- Wellness Kits for Indigenous Students With First Peoples' House
 - With the help of First Peoples' House, the IAC is looking to provide some wellness care throughout the winter months with a gift that students can pick-up.
