 - Candidates Debate: April 9, 2024 in the evening, Depending on availability of Elections SSMU (at least 24 hours before polling period)
 - Polling Period: April 10, 2024 9:00AM to April 19, 2024 5:00PM

Be it further resolved that the Board of Directors vote to ratify the timeline set below via email approval so the Nomination Period can start on Monday, March 25, 2024.

Should further time-sensitive changes be required, the Elections SSMU team will make final changes to the timeline to adequately support the electoral process.
