| Background and Rationale | | The budget was produced in collaboration with the managers and officers of the SSMU, with significant help from the Comptroller and Assistant Comptroller of the SSMU. There is still a projected deficit, though it is smaller than that of the 2023-24 October Revised Budget. This deficit represents the minimum costs to maintain our current operations, and there is very little to reduce in this realm without reducing operations. Reducing operations falls outside the scope of the budget and the responsibilities of the VP Finance. As always, staff salaries and benefits compose the majority of the deficit. | | | |

Consultations Completed

Consultations were completed with all managers and officers of the SSMU, the Comptroller, the General Manager, and the VP Finance.

Risk Factors and Resource Implications

The primary risk factor, as was the case in previous years, is the deficit. This budget minimizes existing costs as much as possible while maintaining our current operations. Reducing current operations falls outside the scope of the budget. Approving this budget does not mean that reducing current operations is not an option, simply that it requires more extensive consultation and consideration. Should internal changes occur, they can be accounted for in the October Revised Budget.

Additionally, a smaller deficit reduces the fee that may be required in the case of a fee increase, increasing the likelihood that one may pass.

Sustainability Considerations

The financial sustainability of the SSMU has been considered for this budget.

Impact of Decision and Next Steps

Once this motion passes, this will be the effective budget for the 2024-25 Fiscal Year.
