Appendix B: Building and Operations Management Committee

28. BUILDING AND OPERATIONS MANAGEMENT COMMITTEE

27.1 OVERSIGHT.

The Building and Operations Management Committee shall be a Committee of the Board of Directors.

27.2 GENERAL.

The primary responsibilities of the Building and Operations Management Committee shall be to provide strategic oversight and direction for the SSMU's physical operations, facilitate the disbursement of eighty-five (85) per cent of the Space Fee on building improvements, and provide long-term objectives and goals for the management of the University Centre.

27.3 RESPONSIBILITIES.

The Building and Operations Management Committee shall:

- a) have the authority to allocate monies from the portion of the Space Improvement Fee for allocation by the Building and Operations Management Committee in a manner consistent with the Governance Documents;
- b) make recommendations to the Board of Directors on the selection, removal, or renewal of building tenants;
- c) review the functionality of all Society run food and beverage operations;
- d) review fees associated with room bookings and building damages at least once per Year;
- e) Consider sustainability in all decisions pertaining to the University Centre and adherence to SSMU Governing Documents
- f) meet at least once per month; and
- g) meet during the business day.

27.4 MEMBERSHIP.

The Building and Operations Management Committee shall consist of:

- a) Operations Coordinator (Committee Chair, non-voting);
- b) the Vice-President (Sustainability and Operations)
- c) the Vice-President (Finance);
- d) President;
- e) Building Director;
- f) Internal Events Coordinator;
- g) One (1) Director, as elected by the Board of Directors;
- h) One (1) Councillor, as elected by the Legislative Council;
- i) One (1) Member at Large, as selected by the Chair;

27.5 ROLE OF THE VICE-PRESIDENT (FINANCE).

The Vice-President (Finance) shall be an advisory member but shall vote on fees and on decisions regarding the selection, removal, or renewal of building tenants.

27.6 REPORTING.

The Building and Operations Management Committee shall submit a semesterly report to both the Legislative Council and the Board of Directors.

- i) One (1) Report in September for the end of the Summer Semester
- ii) One (1) Report in December for the end of the Fall Semester
- iii) One (1) Report in April for the end of the Winter Semester

27.7 ABBREVIATION.

The official abbreviation of the Building and Operations Management Committee shall be the "BOMCOM".
