VP Academic:

- On-boarded the committees for peer tutoring for engineering courses and the largest engineering networking event (TechFair)
- Worked with professors and departmental VP Academics to allocate funds for academic teaching
- Attended faculty meetings as an undergraduate representative
- Met with the departmental VP Academics to discuss issues or initiatives

VP Finance:

- Approved the 2024-25 budget

- Completed finance training for every financial officer in the EUS
- Updated the financial guidebook
