increased demand for free reusable menstrual products and gender affirming gear as students face the rising cost of living. The SSMU Menstrual Health Project was formed partially to address this need, but there are students with needs beyond what the Project fulfills: the UGE provides more variety in product style and distributes products constantly, not only once a month. The UGE has been providing menstrual products to students for decades.

In addition, the cost of outreach events has risen due to increased food prices and increased demand for public transportation tickets as an accessibility measure, which now well exceeds what was observed before Winter 2020.

The UGE has been forced to reduce its staff of coordinators and insufficiently stock its co-operative due to these financial constraints. Further, the UGE has been unable to invest resources into the maintenance of its library.

As the current fee is not enough to keep the union well staffed, its co-op well stocked, and its operations supported, additional funding is required to offer these services to meet growing student demands.

### Alignment with Mission

This motion is presented in accordance with the SSMU's constitutional mandate to support student groups of the McGill community and provide services to strengthen the educational, cultural, environmental, political, and social conditions of its Members. This motion is also in line with the SSMU's commitments to support the UGE under the Equity Policy and the Trans Advocacy Plan. The proposed increase to the Referral Services Fee would allow the Union for Gender Empowerment to continue to provide excellence and quality of service at all times, and to enhance the quality and scope of these services, in further alignment with the SSMU's mandate.

### Consultations Completed

This motion is the product of consultations between the Union for Gender Empowerment, the SSMU Vice-President (Finance), the Director of Clubs and Services, and the Policy & Advocacy Coordinator.

The Fee amount presented was calculated based on budgetary calculations made by the UGE in consultation with the Vice-President (Finance). The Policy & Advocacy Coordinator provided opinions regarding the editing of this motion.

I have read and completed the requirements outlined in the Consultation Policy.

Risk Factors and Resource Implications Should the proposed increase of the Referral Services Fee fail to pass, the UGE will have no choice but to continue funding its services in a manner insufficient for their full provision to members. As the UGE's co-operative is already limited in stock, this would in particular prevent students from accessing vital resources.

Impact of Decision and Next Steps

Should this motion and the subsequent referendum question be adopted, the revised Referral Service Fee allocation would be as follows:

The \$1.25 increase to the UGE's allocation would yield approximately \$45,000 in additional revenue. This would grant the long term financial stability needed for continued operation of the service, while enabling the service to keep up with the rising cost of goods. This increase would enable the UGE to operate with no compromise on service for the students.

A complete current UGE budget is available in Appendix A and a projected UGE budget should the fee increase pass is available in Appendix B.

Motion or Resolution for Approval *Be it resolved, that* the Legislative Council approve the following question for the Winter 2025 referendum period, titled "Referral Services Fee Increase (Union for Gender Empowerment)":

> Whereas, the Union for Gender Empowerment (UGE) is a SSMU Referral Service that provides free menstrual and gender-affirming products,

> Whereas, the price of menstrual and gender-affirming products has increased steeply since the UGE fee was last increased in Winter 2020, before the COVID pandemic,

Do you agree to the increase of the **opt-outable** SSMU Referral Services Fee from \$6.03 per student per semester to \$7.28 per student per semester beginning in Fall 2025 until Winter 2028 (inclusive), at which point it will be brought back to the Membership for renewal, with the understanding that a majority 'no' vote will result in the UGE being unable to meet the demands of the student body, particularly in the provision of menstrual and gender-affirming products?

Be it further resolved, that the Legislative Council adopts the actionable aspects of this question with the understanding that any necessary non-substantive changes will not require the approval of the Legislative Council.
