INTERNAL REGULATIONS OF STUDENT GROUPS-03: ACCREDITED GROUPS OF THE STUDENTS' SOCIETY OF MCGILL UNIVERSITY

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9. Service Employment

9.1. Priority of Hiring

When hiring regular part-time staff under a SSMU Service, the following priority shall apply:

- a. Union members,
- b. SSMU Members,
- c. non-SSMU McGill students, and
- d. Community members, including alumni.

9.2. Restrictions within Employment

Non-student employees of Services can not have voting rights or signing authority on behalf of the Service they are employed by.
