- **Role of the Accountability Commissioner:**
 - Responsible for all matters related to accountability, transparency, and mandate compliance, including upholding and executing the Accountability Plan
 - Chair the Accountability Committee
 - Collaborate with executives and governance team
 - Monitor the implementation of policies and special projects related to accountability
 - Work with SSMU members and constituents to address accountability or mandate-related complaints and disputes
 - Maintain communication with students by reporting to Legislative Council

Activity and Updates

- Working on setting plans and priorities for areas of work during the semester ahead, including the following notable domains:
 - Executive Accountability: Implementing the mandate letters and trackers through upcoming meetings between the SSMU Executives and Accountability Commissioner.
 - Legislative Council Accountability: Measures to bolster councillor attendance and engagement.
 - Outreach: Making the Accountability portfolio more publicly accessible through promotion and external visibility, such as through formal forms, surveys, social media and/or email presence, and in-person presence at relevant meetings.
