1. Campaigns

Anti-Tuition Hikes

- Working on creating educational materials for students about tuition policies.
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2. Outreach

- **Students for Good Jobs** reached out to the External Affairs office seeking support for their employment-related initiatives.
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3. Federal, Provincial & Municipal Political Affairs

- The planned Municipal Election Debate was cancelled; a public statement was subsequently released.
 - Continuing collaboration with UEQ, and confirmed attendance at the upcoming UEQ Conference on November 14.
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4. Community Engagement

- Continuing collaboration with the Comité de Citoyens Milton-Parc (CCMP),



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- SSMU will host a meeting in November.
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5. Affordable Student Housing

- A site visit to the UTILE student housing building is planned for November 11, alongside other SSMU executives.
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6. Solidarity Funding Committee / Community Solidarity Fund

- A committee meeting is scheduled for Monday to review pending summer applications.
 - Following consultations with the Vice-President (Finance), Community Affairs Coordinator, External Affairs Commissioner, and Policy and Advocacy Coordinator, a motion to change the committee's composition is being presented to Legislative Council.
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7. Francophone Affairs

- The second Francophone Affairs Fund (FAF) meeting took place in October, and funding allocations are now being processed.

- The **Political Campaigns Protocol** is expected to be finalized and presented at the **next Legislative Council meeting**.
