

# Background

Plebiscite questions are non-binding questions that are used to acquire the opinion of SSMU members. Historically, they often run alongside the ballot of Fall and Winter referenda. According to the Internal Regulations of Elections and Referenda, Legislative Council shall approve semesterly by the end of the Nomination Period for Referendum questions a list of no more than ten (10) single-part questions on which students will be asked to voice their opinion at the bottom of the Elections ballot.

For the Fall 2025 Referendum, there was 1 plebiscite question, introduced via a floor motion by Vice President Abu Alakir at the Legislative Council on October 9th, 2025. The question reads: "What event would you like to see on campus?" and was an open ended question.

The voter turnout for the Fall 2025 Referendum was **19.1%**, which **4829** SSMU members voted (out of 25332 eligible members). Out of the people who voted, **541** members elected to submit a response for the plebiscite question. **21** responses had no events to propose, with responses such as: "Idk" (Response 182), "Not sure" (Response 337), "Nothing really" (Response 399), "Rien en particulier" (Response 370), "ummm no clue" (Response 534).

# Rationale & Methodology

The report aims to summarize overarching themes submitted by the members, in order to help SSMU see what the students want. The list of responses was exported from SimplyVoting by Elections SSMU, then a quick first pass of the responses were done. Afterwards, common themes/tags are assigned for each response, which is the basis of completing this report.

It is to be noted that the response submission is anonymous. It is not associated with any data (no timestamp, no faculty, not associated with other votes), and that SSMU members should not hesitate to provide their opinion in these questions.

The responses are numbered from 1 to 541 according to the order SimplyVoting presented it in, which was alphabetically. The sequence does not identify the individual, and is not ordered by time of submission.



# Recommendations from Elections SSMU

# **Increase diversity of events**

While many of SSMU's current events (e.g. Midnight on McTavish) is well-liked and should be continued, the SSMU also needs to keep in mind the high demand for other students captured in the plebiscite data, such as - plays, art contests, movie nights, book clubs, trivia, scavenger hunts, and board game nights. By offering a broader calendar of activities, the SSMU can ensure students who do not engage with high-alcohol, high-energy functions still have the opportunity to participate in campus life, and be more aware of SSMU and its resources.

# Consider SSMU members come from various backgrounds

There are more than 25,000 SSMU members across many faculties and programs, ranging from Montréal to Gatineau. Due to this, SSMU needs to make sure all demographics are considered for events, and that no students should feel left out. Some overlooked demographics mentioned in the survey include mature students, graduating students, commuting students, and non-traditional students.

# Promote inclusivity and social cohesion

Effective community building requires creating spaces where all students feel genuinely welcomed, regardless of their social preferences, physical abilities, or background. In the survey many took the opportunity to express wanting to meet students outside their program/faculty. As the student union for undergraduate students, SSMU has the unique position to create interfaculty or even interuniversity events, something faculty student associations have less of a chance to do.




The SSMU should also consider consulting with groups on campus such as LGBTQ+, BIPOC, and various cultural/religious groups to ensure events are inclusive and these groups feel included. At the same time, the SSMU should promote social cohesion - ensuring different groups of students on campus can have a chance to meet and have healthy discussions; no matter ethnicity, political beliefs, and religion.

### Consider basic needs of students

The overwhelming response of free food and free events recognizes that many students are financially conscious, and SSMU needs to recognize this, in times of inflation and food insecurity. There are also concerns from members that money is not always well spent at SSMU. In general, the SSMU should strive to eliminate additional fees wherever possible, ensuring maximum participation, and is not limited by a students' ability to pay.


