### **Portfolios**

#### **➤ President**

- Science Student Census is at 1000 responses! ~18% of Faculty
- Working on MoA renewal.
- Working on major financial restructuring projects with the VP Finance.
- Faculty of Science Council had a conversation on the Policy on Assessment of Student Learning on Tuesday.
- Met with the Director of Student Services.
- Working with the AUS and ASUS Presidents on improving our relationship and governance structure.

#### **➤ Executive Administrator**

- Added a centralized service booking form on the SUS website.

#### **➤ VP Finance**

- Major financial restructuring projects, specifically concerning the reimbursement process with the goal of reducing wait times.
- Working on creating more resources for departmental and clubs/services VP Finances (ex: how to use Square terminal, live actuals).
- Will be working with AUS VP Finance to clarify equalization for Arts-Science departments.
- Tying up Science Games finances.

#### **➤ VP Internal**

- Science Games finished; compiling exit reports
- The Science Internal Committee organized and is planning multiple events over the Winter semester.
  - McGill Acapella Riff-Off
  - St. Patty's Day Crawl

#### **➤ VP Academic**

- Finished dealing with Grad Fair finances.



- Planning PASL information sessions for students and professors to be hosted at the end of January and beginning of February.
- Committees under the academic portfolio are working on increasing engagement and spreading awareness (ex: PASL information posts)
- **VP Communications**
  - Reviewed multiple departmental constitutions to host General Assemblies.
  - Updated the SUS website and is working on its translation.
  - Finalizing “SUS structure” to explain the diverse roles, connections, and overall structure of the SUS.
- **VP External**
  - Seven new clubs have all been approved, have signed their contracts, and filled out their budgets.
  - Secured some sponsorships for SUS committees and created a sponsorship package for Science Games.
- **VP Sustainability**
  - Hosted a Sustainability Roundtable with representatives from every SUS department, to discuss new projects, initiatives and get feedback.
  - Charity Week happened in November with multiple events during the week and all the money raised went to an organization (Centraide), alongside events from the other Sustainability committees.
- **Science Senator**
  - Submitting senate question regarding PASL’s enforcement and accountability on a University-wide scale
  - Discussing usage of AI in the classroom via an open discussion at Senate
  - Presently interviewing for the next Dean of Science along with the President
