Equity Baskets Initiative

- 100 equity baskets being organized to be distributed on December 3rd and 4th to low-income students
- 70% food, 20% hygiene products, 10% stationary etc.
- Partnering with the Food Pantry and Gerts Cafe, with merch from Wellness Hub (and potentially Menstrual Health Project)
- Budget coming out of equity fund with VP UA's support (around \$4000)
- Food and hygiene products coming from Costco

Winter Carnaval

- Working with McGill Administration for [festive Winter Market](#) celebrating Quebec and Indigenous culture on lower field in January/February
- In contact (or have contacted) DPSL's office, Campus Life & Engagement, Indigenous Affairs Commissioner, First People's House, Francophone Affairs Commissioner, OAP Organizers, McGill Ground Operations, potential food vendors (Beavertails, Sugarshack, Indigenous food vendors etc.)
- President of McGill on board to have hot chocolate and discussion with students (still being confirmed)
- DPSL's office is currently helping identify the right people to get involved in this: final Winter Carnaval working group will be formed soon (in the next week or so?)
