- Co-hosted ASUS x SACS Valentine’s Care Package Initiative: assembled 70 care packages for Native women’s shelters including menstrual health products and hygiene supplies.
- Organized and funded Douze-à-Deux “Rabbit Hole-a-thon” interdisciplinary exploration event (rescheduled for March 29 for expanded participation).
- Organizing and preparing Interdisciplinary Case Competition (March 15–20) featuring two prompts:
 - Hive Mind (Cognitive Science)
 - Green Utopia (Sustainability / Social Sciences)
Includes monetary prizes and collaboration with SACS, SASSS, and MESS.
- Developing an interdisciplinary environmental networking panel in collaboration with RSN, PopSci, and McGill Energy Journal.
- Initiated collaboration with CreARTE and Building 21 alumni to revive “Art of Science” programming (artist–scientist talks and workshops).
- Completed development of the ASUS website and began digital restructuring of ASUS’s online presence.
- Secured and began revitalizing ASUS office space; applied for space improvement funding.
- Holding bi-weekly meetings with externals.
