

Proposed MCC bylaws

1. The name of the organization is the McGill Communities Council. The purpose of the Council is to advance the interests of the communities that work, teach, and study at McGill.
2. The Council may admit and remove member organizations by a two-thirds vote when notice has been given to each member at least one week in advance. Each member organization is represented by one member designated by certification to the secretary for a term of no more than one year.
3. The only officer of the Council is a Chair secretary, who is elected at the first meeting on or after September 1 for a term of one year.
4. The Council, the Chairs, or a majority of the members may schedule meetings by giving reasonable notice to each member. At all meetings, ten members or a majority of the members constitute a quorum.
5. The Council may take actions in its own name by a vote at a meeting, but no public statement may be issued in its name except by a two-thirds vote.
6. The Council may amend these bylaws by a two-thirds vote when notice has been given to each member at least one week in advance
